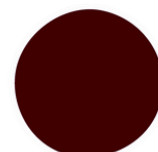

! *Community Night*

The 2025 Summit Community Night provides an opportunity for local and area non-profit organizations to promote their work to Summit residents. The event is held in conjunction with the Hot Summer Nights Concert Series on Tuesday, July 15, 2025. Participating organizations can begin setup at 5PM and must be ready for visitors by 6:30PM. Organizations must provide their own table and chairs and are permitted to have one table no longer than eight feet in length. Pop-up tents are permitted and must be no larger than 10 feet by 10 feet in size. No fundraising by participating organizations is permitted during Community Night.

! *Memorial Day Parade*

All non-profits are invited to join us to march as a group in Summit's Annual Memorial Day Parade on May 26, 2025. The parade will depart from 52 Deforest Ave at 10AM. Marching groups are invited to unite behind their banner in marching. Upon arrival at the Village Green, prior to the start of the Memorial Day ceremony, all groups are asked to please have their banners stowed away.

! *Fourth of July*

At the Fourth of July event, any non-profit organization is welcome to become a part of the non-profit vendor fair. Non-profit organizations that are a part of this event will not be considered sponsors. The non-profit vendor rate is \$400 to have a table for the duration of the event.

National Night Out

Every year, the Summit Police Department and Summit Community Programs host the annual National Night Out Against Crime. This year, National Night Out (NNO) will be held on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, on Summit's Village Green. Summit's finest organizations and community agencies will be on hand for an evening of education, entertainment, and community. Opening ceremonies begin at 6PM. Summit's NNO has been recognized as one of the largest in the state of New Jersey. With the support of our corporate sponsors, NNO has become one of the most popular nights in Summit during the summer months.

Pet Show
